Dr. Kitty Little: 'The Turin Shroud: How was the Image Formed?'

Following our very well attended Autumn Meeting on 26 October, 1994, with its entertaining and well-received talk by magic lantern specialist Doug Lear, our Spring Meeting will likewise be held at the Society of Authors in South Kensington. This was agreed by all to be a very pleasant location.

For this Spring Meeting our speaker will be Dr. Kitty Little, M.A., B.Sc., D.Ph.
