

BRITISH PARTICIPATION IN ANY FUTURE TESTING

In November last year Fr. Peter Rinaldi telephoned specifically to invite a set of British testing proposals. With regard to radiocarbon dating, the involvement of the Oxford Research Laboratory for Archaeology and the History of Art and the Low Level Measurements Laboratory, Harwell, have already been included in STURP's proposals for radiocarbon dating as put forward by Dr. Robert Dinigar. Dr. Dinigar has made available a copy of these proposals, and depending on the British involvement being sustained, the proposals are warmly supported by us here in Britain. It is quite obvious that for the British general public radiocarbon dating is *the* test that needs to be done - and soon!
