

Rev. Kazimierz Panuś, Professor in Theological Sciences at the Pope John Paul II University in Cracow, the Head of the Department of Homiletics of the Faculty of Theology. Since 1996 he has been a President of the Polish Theological Society in Cracow. He deals with the history of preaching in Poland and the Common Church; author of 40 books and over 100 articles.

Rev. Kazimierz Panuś was born on 5 February 1955 in Myślenice. He has been a priest in the Krakow Archdiocese since 1980. He obtained the Master's Degree on 7 March 1980 in the Pontifical Faculty of Theology in Krakow on the basis of the thesis entitled: *Schemat dziejów ludzkości w*

«De civitate Dei» św. Augustyna (The outline of the history of mankind in «De civitate Dei» by St. Augustin), written under the academic supervision of rev. prof. Marian Michalski, PhD. He took the orders on 18 May 1980. He was given the Licentiate Degree in 1986 based on the thesis entitled: Sw. Patryk- wzorem chrzescijańskiego misjonarza. (St. Patrick- following the model of a Christian Missionary), written under the direction of rev. ass. prof. Edward Stańka, PhD. He was awarded his Doctor's Degree on 17 May 1989 on the basis of the doctoral dissertation entitled: Ideal chrześcijanina i metody jego realizacji w «Mowach» Sw. Leona Wielkiego (The ideal of a Christian and methods of its realization in "«Speeches» by St. Leon the Great), supervised by rev. ass. professor Edward Staniek, PhD., reviewers: rev. prof. Antoni Lewek, PhD. and rev. prof. Marek Starowieyski, PhD.. He got the academic degree of an associate professor -Doctor Habilitatus of Theological Sciences in Homiletics in the Faculty of Theology at the Pontifical Academy of Theology in Krakow based on the colloquium conducted on 28 February 1997 and the habilitation thesis entitled: «Uratować naród!» Glos z ambonv katedrv wawelskiej okresu niewoli narodowej1795-1918 («Save the Nation!» A voice from the pulpit in the Wawel Cathedral in the period of the Polish captivity 1795-1918) (Krakow 1996). In 2002, having completed the professor's programme, he was awarded the academic title of a Professor in Theological Sciences.

Rev. Kazimierz Panuś holds a number of important functions. Since 1996 he has been a President of the Polish Theological Society in Krakow. From 2006 to 2009 he was the Vice- Rector at the Pontifical Academy of Theology in Krakow (since 19 VI 2009 the Pontifical University of John Paul II). At present, he is the Head of the Department of Homiletics of the Faculty of Theology at the Pope John Paul II University and a member of the Committee of Theological Sciences at the Polish Academy of Sciences.

He deals with the history of preaching in Poland and the Common Church. He is the author of a three-volume synthesis of the history of preaching in Poland and the Common Church: Zarys historii kaznodziejstwa w Polsce i w Kościele Powszechnym (An outline of the history of preaching in Poland and the Catholic Church) (Krakow 1999-2001) and the books: Kaznodziejstwo w Katedrze Wawelskiej (Preaching in the Wawel Cathedral) (parts 1-2 Krakow 1995), Uratować Naród! Głos z ambony Katedry Wawelskiej okresu niewoli narodowej 1975-1918 (Save the Nation! A voice from the pulpit in the Wawel Cathedral in the period of the Polish captivity 1795-1918) (Krakow 1996), Wielcy mówcy Kościoła w Polsce (The Great Preachers of Church in Poland) (2005), Henryk Lacordaire (Krakow 2005), Św. Leon Wielki (St. Leon the Great) (Krakow 2005), Wielcy kaznodzieje Krakowa (The Great Preachers of Krakow) (Krakow 2006, ed.), St. Jan Vianney (Krakow 2006), Piotr Skarga (Krakow 2006), Historia kaznodziejstwa (The History of Preaching) (Krakow 2007), Wielcy mówcy katedry na Wawelu (The Great Preachers of the Wawel Cathedral) (Krakow 2008), Sztuka głoszenia kazań (The Art of Preaching) (Krakow 2008), Bl. Edmund Bojanowski (Krakow 2009) and over 100 articles.
