

## VISIT BY TOM D'MUHALA AND DR. JOHN JACKSON

Mindful of Cardinal Ballestrero's recommendations concerning collaboration with other Shroud groups, the very same evening of the meeting Tom D'Muhala telephoned Ian Wilson from Turin, and arranged to meet at Heathrow while on stop-over during their return to the States. It was agreed that STURP and the BSTS would endeavour to work together in a further enhanced spirit of openness and co-operation.

Although as yet no full copy has been received of the proposals as presented to Cardinal Ballestrero, in late December Dr. Jackson released a long document setting out the general thrust of the researches STURP hope to pursue, specifically inviting competent groups and individuals to correspond with them on specific research areas. This invitation inevitably includes members of the BSTS, and accordingly we are pleased to reproduce the document in full as part of this *Newsletter*. As members will note, the document includes a useful bibliography of all STURP publications to date.
