The Shroud on Film and the Magic Lantern...

For the next meeting of the society we are experimenting with a new venue, the Board Room of the Society of Authors at 84, Drayton Gardens, London SW10. To be held on Wednesday 26 October at the usual time of 7pm. the meeting will be a triple bill consisting of (1) the Society's AGM; (2) The premiere showing in England of Dutch film-maker Roel Oostra's 40 minute English language documentary on the Shroud, which includes interviews with Professor Michael Tite; Isabel Piczek; Professor James Cameron; Dr. Alan Whanger; the late Professor Jerome Lejeune; Professor Gino Zaninotto and Dr. Dmitri Kouznetsov; and (3) 'The Magic Lantern and the Shroud', a short presentation by Doug Lear, owner of the U.K's finest collection of magic lanterns and magic lantern slides, who has recently become intrigued by special properties of the Shroud's image when seen by the magic lantern and 'thrown' by Japanese mirrors.
